Here's a reminder and update about the July 4th ersatz Lake Forest Parade. As you know, because of the Coronavirus, the City of Lake Forest will not be hosting their usual July forth parade this year. But the folks of Just Having Fun ("JHF") decided to step up and have one anyway. They've notified a number of residents in several neighborhoods and have mapped out a route (see below), where folks will be sitting on their curbs and in their front yards to watch all the special cars parade by. So far, 35 cars have committed including several from PCC. JHF has, in addition to their own usual participants, invited cars from PCC, South Orange County Rods and Customs, Hot Rods Unlimited, Cool Running Camaros, DeLoreans, Thunderbirds, Model As, Jeeps, and Minis. It seems to me that their original estimate of 50 participating will be easily met, and there will be an eclectic and interesting array of participants.

So, take advantage of this chance to meet some new friends, enjoy your Vette, get out safely during this quarantine. And have some fun. If you wish, be prepared to show your patriotism and decorate your car, but be judicious about it as the route will take us along a couple arterials (e.g., Jeronimo Road, Ridge Route, Toledo, and El Toro Roads) at speeds of about 20 MPH or so, so you don't want your decorations to blow off. There will be a place in the last neighborhood to pull over and undecorate before you have to drive in traffic. **Prospective new members of PCC take note – this event will be considered as an official PCC event for participation points accumulation.**

Details are as follows.

Date: 4th of July

Staging: El Conejito at 24331 Muirlands Blvd, Lake Forest

Arrival: 10:00 (revised to allow more time to add decorations)

Parade: 10:30

Lunch: 11:30 – Lucille's - 23760 El Toro Rd.

The cruise/parade through the neighborhoods will be at about 5 MPH or so, and should take about 45 minutes to complete. The current planned route is described below.

Meet up: El Conejito 24331 Muirlands Blvd 10:15 (10:00 if you plan to decorate your Vette.)

Ridge Route to Partido – make a left

Left on Hummingbird Lane which turns into Singing Woods

Right on Fallen Leaf Road

Left on Dove Tree Lane

Right on Toledo Way

Left on Ridge Route

Left on Cineria Way

Left on Wandering Lane

Left on Timberland Way

Right onto Toledo Way

Right on Rim View Drive

Left on Canyon Rim Place which turns into Windward Way

Right on Timberwood Way

Left on Shadyvale Lane

Right on Lake Forest

Right on Buffwood Lane

Left on Trailway Lane

Right on Windwood Ln

Left on Dayton Drive

Left on Timberline Way

Right on Ginger Road and back out

Left on Timberline Way

Left on Dayton Drive

Left on Serrano

Left on Lake Forest

Right on Jeronimo Road

Left on Eagle Street

Left on Peacock Street which turns into Crane Street

Right on Sparrow

Right on Wren Way

Right on Pheasant Street

Left on Robin Street

Right on Peacock Street

Left on Eagle Street

Right onto Jeronimo Road

Right on Lake Forest

Left on Rockfield Boulevard

Right on White Dove Drive

Right on Quail Way and return

Right on Blue Bird Drive

Left on Swan Drive

Left on White Dove Drive

Right on Rockfield Boulevard- go past El Toro Road

Left on Orchard Lane to Lucille's
