WHAT: An SCCA-sanctioned Navigational (Time/Speed/Distance) RoadRally.

WHEN: Saturday February 13th, departing in the morning and finishing before noon

The drivers meeting will be held online the night before the event at 7:00 PM

WHERE: We'll start at the Walmart Supercenter located at 13487 Camino Canada, El Cajon, CA 92021 heading east into the back roads of San Diego County

PRICE: The entry fee is \$25 per car.

The Driver must be an [SCCA Member](#), note that weekend memberships are available for \$15 (and these can be used as credit for a full membership)

AWARDS: Results will be posted online and trophies awarded to the top finishers in each class of car. Time results available through free road rally competitor app at event.

The object of a navigational rally is to follow the rally course at the assigned (legal) speed at each checkpoint on time; not early, not late. Your score on each leg of the rally is bas or late you arrive at each checkpoint.
