



Pacific Coast Corvettes 2020 Scholarship Application

The Pacific Coast Corvettes (PCC) club scholarship in the amount of \$2500 will be offered to an eligible candidate(s) who is a graduating senior at a high school within the Saddleback Valley Unified School District in Orange County, California, or a student enrolled in Saddleback College in Auto Tech program. Because PCC wishes to encourage the continued advanced development of automotive technology and automobile enthusiast activities, this Scholarship is supportive of but not necessarily limited to that end. The scholarship will be awarded on a one academic year basis. To be eligible to receive this scholarship grant, applicants must have been accepted by an accredited college or university, post-secondary school, or technical trade school and planning to enroll or be enrolled in at least 12 class hours per semester. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing a S.T.E.A.M. major or be enrolled in a technical school related to the design, development, maintenance or repair of automotive or automotive products. Other qualifications being equal, preference will be given to those applicants who are able to demonstrate a genuine interest in automobiles and automotive related activities.

While academic performance and extracurricular activities will be considered, apparent financial need and work and/or volunteer experience, particularly in an automotive related field, will also be considered in the application review process. Applicants must provide a statement of the source of their funds for their education (i.e., loans, other scholarships, grants, savings, employment, etc.).

To be considered for the scholarship award, the applicant must meet the following requirements.

- ❖ Submittal by April 17th of a completed application package (i.e., [1] the completed Scholarship Applicant form, Personal References form, Application Questionnaire, and Financial Data form, [2] a copy of applicant's official transcript, [3] a copy of a letter of acceptance to a two or four year college, or accredited trade school, and [4] an essay as described below.)

The PCC Scholarship Committee will consider all information provided by each of the scholarship applicants and determine, in its sole discretion, that applicant who best suited to meet the intent and purpose of PCC in offering this scholarship. The decision of the PCC Scholarship Committee is final.

Selection of the intended scholarship recipient will be made by May 1st, and the scholarship disbursement will be made in September subject to verification of enrolment. Scholarship funds may be, at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, remitted to the selected applicant or directly to the school. Scholarship recipients who fail to provide proof of enrollment in an approved university or college major, or trade school program, within the allotted time may have their scholarship award selection revoked and the scholarship award may be given to another qualified applicant.
