BACKYARD MECHANIC

Greetings PCC'ers! In this episode, I'll talk to you about some necessary modifications and upgrades to The Red Rocket to enhance her performance and most importantly, to keep her legal in the State of California!

When I purchased my 1999 C5 Corvette Convertible, it came with some modifications done by the previous owner. Along with non-pop up headlights, he had installed an aftermarket air intake system that I unfortunately discovered was not California Air Resources Board (CARB) compliant. I contacted the manufacturer of the errant air intake system in the hopes that they made a CARB compliant model but to no avail.

So, I was on my own to either reinstall the original factory air intake system which the previous owner gave me or, try to find an aftermarket air intake system that would address both performance and legality.



Thankfully, Callaway Performance manufacturers a Honker Air Intake system for the C5 Corvette that guarantees a performance improvement and is CARB compliant.

I purchased this Honker system and fully intended to install it myself. But as we all know, life somehow intrudes to prevent the best of intentions. I'm pretty good as a Backyard Mechanic but even I have limitations. So what to do? How could I get this system installed correctly with minimal down-time?

Thanks to Carl Jablonski's experience having Callaway install his supercharger on his C8, he recommended that I contact them about installing their Honker system on my Corvette.

A call to Callaway determined that they indeed would love to install their Honker and boy, am I glad I chose to have them do it. You see, when the previous owner installed his aftermarket air intake, he cut the radiator shroud as required. When Callaway started the Honker installation on my 'Vette, they discovered that the cut radiator shroud had a hole that was too wide for the correct installation of the Honker.

Not to worry, their shop in Temecula specializes in unique automotive issues so with a couple of pieces of carbon fiber, they modified my errant radiator shroud to accept the Honker with no issues. The installation went flawlessly and I even had them install some radiator covers painted to match The Red Rocket's Magnetic Red Metallic paint. If you look good... you are good!

The most important aspect of installing Callaway's Honker Air Intake System is the CARB sticker that comes with the kit. And I've already passed my latest smog test!



There are very few items about my C5 Corvette that I dislike. One of the most egregious items is the stock 6-speed manual shifter. Shifting from second to third, or even worse - fourth to fifth - made me feel like my arm just wasn't long enough to make that shifting throw! And if you've every been stuck in interminable stop and go traffic, you'll truly wish you had an automatic transmission.

Callaway Performance thankfully makes a shift mechanism that addresses this short-coming. The Callaway S4 Shifter for the C5 Corvette is an incredibly smooth, although pricey, solution to my stock shifter issues.

Because the entire center console has to be removed to install this new shifter, I opted once again to have Callaway

install it at their Temecula facility. Installation took only a couple of hours and the shifting improvement was dramatic. A quick flick of the wrist smoothly and effort-lessly moves the transmission through the gears. A gentle push is all that is re-

quired to shift from second to third. Magical!

The shifter is optimized for performance so the easiest transitions are from third to fourth and back again. No longer do I have to "hunt" for the correct gear placement. This upgrade was definitely a wise decision.

In keeping with the "If you look good ... you are good" theme, I opted to dress up the shifter with a cue ball knob appropriately adorned with Corvette stuff. I needed to add a locking nut to the shifter shaft to keep the cue ball centered.

So now, driving is even more pleasant than it ever was before.


