
A Look in the Rear View Mirror By Donna Friess



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

The only real issue we had was trying to find an appropriate weather seal strip that protects the trunk from water intrusion - parts for a 26 year old C5 are becoming a bit difficult to find. The weatherstrip had to be replaced because GM in their infinite wisdom, glued the original weatherstrip in place. Thankfully, a C6 weatherstrip fits! So that is what got installed.

European Motor Car Works had my car for almost 4 weeks but the wait was truly worth it. They not only repaired the damage perfectly, but they buffed the entire car to better than show-room quality! It looks prettier now than ever before.





As you can tell, I am very pleased with the efforts of European Motor Car Works to return The Red Rocket to me in pristine condition. The only issue remaining is that the left rear wheel still needs to be replaced - it is a custom wheel and has been ordered. I should have it soon.



What IS CAGS Author: William Rose





Hello all, allow me to introduce myself. My name is Bill Rose, and I am a prospect for PCC corvette club. I am writing this article for two reasons. One is to get points, second is to help others.

At the last cars in coffee event on 6/14/25 in San Clemente I was talking with other Corvette owners and discovered that those with a C7 seven speed were having the same issue I was having with the CAGS feature programed into the C7.

Transmission CAGS...

What is CAGS?

To avoid a gas guzzler tax, Chevrolet invented a skip-shift device on its manual transmission cars called Computer-Aided Gear Selection, or CAGS. CAGS forces you to shift your manual Vette from first to fourth (rather than second or third) when:

- 1. Engine temp is greater than 169 F
- 2. Vehicle speed is 15 -19 mph.
- **3.** Throttle is open 21% or less.

Under more spirited acceleration CAGS does not interfere.

This feature is annoying and can be programed out with a tuner and AFM (active fuel management) can also be turned off.

This programmer can also help the C7 autos as well. This tuner has many more features like throttle sensitivity, fan control, and it is 50 state legal.

What tuner is it. It's the Diablo Intune 3 made by Holley. You can also gain about 15hp. If you have any questions, you can reach out to me 949-285-4061. Thank you.
