

NCRS Meet

The National Corvette Restoration Society (NCRS) Southern California Chapter held a judging meet on 20 and 21 September. The Meet was at Singleton Classics in Costa Mesa. Singleton

Classics has an extensive automobile collection established by Will and Cary Singleton.

There were eight Corvettes judged, two of which are owned by Pacific Coast Corvettes members Gary Lane and Jim Burra. Gary entered his silver

1966 Coupe and Jim entered his red 1990

ZKI.

NCRS judging is extensive and precise. The goal is showroom originality.

There are five categories:

Operations, Mechanical, Interior, Exterior and Chassis. Two judges are engaged in each category. They use NCRS Scoring Sheets which are tailored to each Corvette's classification. The judging started on Friday evening and continued through most of the day on Saturday. Corvette owners are present during the judging process so that they can open and operate their cars as instructed by the judges. At the end of each session, the judges review their results with the owner.

Within a few weeks, copies of the judging sheets will be made available to the entrants. The sheets provide a road map for upgrading the owner's Corvettes so that they can attain even higher rankings.

The good news is that Gary's and Jim's
Corvettes were both awarded Top Flight
Certificates - the highest rating possible
at this meet.

Congratulations to both Gary and Jim! They are a source of PCC pride!
